Public Policy

In promoting equity and education for women and girls, AAUW CA champions bills supporting fair pay, equal rights, access to a strong education, LGBT rights, voting rights, and a fair and family-friendly workplace. AAUW also supports comprehensive access to health care, including full reproductive choices, and combating violence against women.

The state's public policy committee studies and recommends action on bills pertaining to the AAUW mission. A legislative advocate communicates AAUW positions on bills to California legislators, while online Two-Minute Activist and Action Alerts systems offer members a direct path to information and action on relevant issues at both the state and national level.
