### Introduction

The Branch Activity of the Year Award is a chance to put forward a signature activity that your branch presented during the period of one year ending on March 1, 2022. This is your branch's chance to showcase and share an activity that is:

- Novel did you do something really unique, such as a play?
- Inspirational did people leave your event inspired to take action on something, such as visiting their legislators or launching a new branch project?
- Reproducible can another branch realistically do a similar event? Would they need a panel of nuclear scientists?
- Reflective of AAUW's mission and image did the event promote one of AAUW's initiatives, which range from such things as gender pay gap to DEI to leadership and career development, or other?

The activity may be a one-off program or event or a sustained recurring project for which your branch is known. Last year's winners were a campaign to collect shoes for the homeless and a year-long series on racism. See descriptions of the 19 events submitted for the award here.

#### What are the awards?

There will be three to five awards. Winning branches will be honored with a small prize and recognition at the 2022 AAUW California Annual Meeting, on the state website, in social media, the *California Connection*, and other AAUW communications.

### More than one program?

Submit an individual application for each program you would like considered. You can submit them as soon as the program has concluded.

Winners will be contacted March 31, 2022.

- Events which received national or state AAUW funding will not be considered for this award, but can certainly be listed in Branch Brag on the website by sending the information to webteam@aauw-ca.org.
- Winners will be expected to provide a 5-10 minute presentation at the Annual Meeting on April 30, 2022. Assistance with your presentation will be available.
